

North Alabama Team Camp

Hueytown HIGH SCHOOL, Hueytown AL

Dates: First Session 5A-7A Schools-4:00pm Wed., July 16th - 4:00pm Thurs., July 17th. Second Session 1A-4A Schools-4:00pm Fri., July 18th-4:00pm Sat., July 19th.

Camp Objective: This camp is for individual instruction on offense and defense. Each position will be coached. Campers receive individualized, group instruction by experienced coaches at all positions on both offense and defense. Offensive game fundamentals taught will be -3 step, quick game, screens and shuffle pass, ball security, as well as catching, throwing and route running skills. Also taught will be base run game skills and all shotgun option skills. O Linemen will learn both passing and run blocking skills, as well as all base trap plays. All defensive line skills will be taught for both pass and run, plus all linebacker and secondary fundamentals will be covered in individual and group sessions. Zone and man fundamentals will be taught in individual and group as well as tackling. This is an Individual camp that your whole team attends. All positions will be instructed in individual and group techniques on both sides of the ball. You will coach your own players in 7 on 7 competitions each night.

Competition: 7 on 7 will be at night. All 7 on 7 will be timed and officiated by camp staff. Teams will play at least 6 games over the two days of camp. Also, there will be 11 vs 11 competitions again.

Facilities: Our home is Hueytown High School, At Hueytown AL. Brand new spectacular facilities with 4 fields and stadium, plenty of air-conditioned sleeping space with showers and restrooms. Located in Birmingham, 5 minutes off I-59 South.

Staff: A staff of 30 coaches that have coached and played at every level of football will be on hand to offer the best there is in football instruction. All staff members will be available during every session, and also will be conducting a 2 hour FOOTBALL SCHOOL video chalk talk for players after lunch the second day of camp.

Supervision: Coaches are expected to supervise and stay with their team at all times. Camp directors will also help but not exclusively supervise. All rules and regulations for Jefferson County Schools will apply while in attendance.

Cost: The entire session will be \$60 per player. We will house the first ten teams that send us a \$500 deposit. Also with a deposit of \$500, the price per player goes down to \$50 a player. Deposit can be returned to you at registration or can be subtracted from your team's total tuition cost. All teams will be responsible for their meals, but we will provide you a list of local eateries.

Medical: All head coaches will be responsible for having an up-to-date physical form for every camper in his possession. Also, a parental consent form signed by a parent or guardian will be required for every camper.

Insurance: Parents are expected to be responsible for medical expenses incurred during camp, just as they are for regular football activities.

What to Bring: For overnight campers, a pillow, blanket and sleeping bag or air mattress. Sleeping areas are provided but beds are not provided. Towels, washcloths, and hygiene products for cleanliness. Showers are provided. Football cleats, helmet and athletic clothing are needed for all practices. Players are encouraged to bring enough clothing to change before each practice. *Do not bring a lot of extra money, jewelry or other valuables.*

Reporting Instructions: Teams should report to register before 4:00pm the day of the first session. Pre-registration would be welcomed. Campers will stay overnight in Hueytown High School gym.
